

**PRIVATE SECTOR CONSTITUENCY  
DECLARATION FORM**

I hereby declare that:

- I will, as the Stop TB Partnership Board's Private Sector Constituency (PSC) member, act only in the organization's best interests and not represent any entity's commercial, political, and/or other interests.
- I do not have any financial and/or other interests in any entity that has requested to enter into a partnership or position with the Stop TB Partnership/United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS). For the purposes of this declaration, a "partnership" shall have the same definition as set out in the UNOPS Organisational Directive 43.
- I have no reason to believe that I and/or a member of my family may receive a benefit, whether financial or non-financial, as a PSC member.
- I do not have any conflict of interest, actual or perceived, related to this position. I understand that a conflict of interest is a situation where a person's private interests — such as outside professional relationships and personal financial assets — interfere or may be perceived to interfere with his/her duties and responsibilities as a member of Stop TB Partnership personnel or otherwise affect or may be perceived to affect his/her independence and impartiality.<sup>1</sup>
- If I become aware of any actual or perceived conflict of interest after I sign this document, I will immediately disclose in writing the conflict to the relevant contact within the Stop TB Partnership Secretariat.
- I will not disclose and/or use the contents of any information acquired through my participation as a PSC member.
- I will not disclose and/or use any other information if it has been identified as, or which should reasonably be believed to be, sensitive, confidential, or proprietary.
- I will follow Stop TB Partnership/UNOPS rules and procedures.
