Outline of the options to host the next CB in Spring: a) EU (through links Netherlands, DFID, Heiniken); b) Germany. If within the next 2 weeks finalization on one of these options, otherwise explore with other potential hosts, such as Norway, Gates foundation. The Board meeting in the 2nd half of November is proposed to be hosted by Stop TB Italy in Assisi, in conjunction with a Ministerial Conference on TB and immigration.
