



Stop TB Kenya begins the partnering process

At the 2011 International Lung Health Conference in Kenya from 5 - 8 October, Kenya Stop TB Partnership placed a stand where the distributed material in order to raise awareness about the existence of the partnership and informing potential partners about how to join the technical working groups or the partnership.
