PROBLEM STATEMENT — To address the problem of people who use drugs who are directly affected by TB, their access to treatment, and human rights in a legal and policy environment that promotes health inequalities among this group. There is a need for a global movement of people affected by TB, championing and operationalizing the rights of people affected by TB, including TB key and vulnerable populations like people who use drugs.

TBpeople is a global network of TB survivors and people affected by TB. TBpeople also has national level affiliates, including TBpeople Ukraine, TBpeople Philippines, and has working MOUs with global HIV key population networks GNP+ and INPUD. The vision of TBpeople is a world free of tuberculosis. Our mission is to unite people, defeat tuberculosis. We are an individual membership-based organization. In 2019 we developed and launched the Declaration of the rights of people affected by TB. We have subsequently had this translated into seven languages and will now work to further operationalize the Declaration at the country level.
