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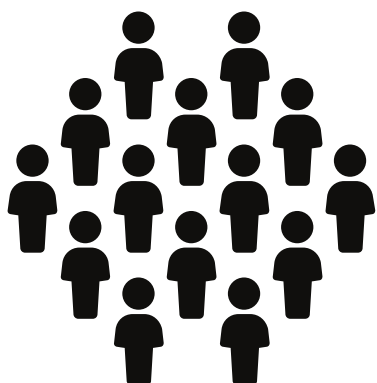

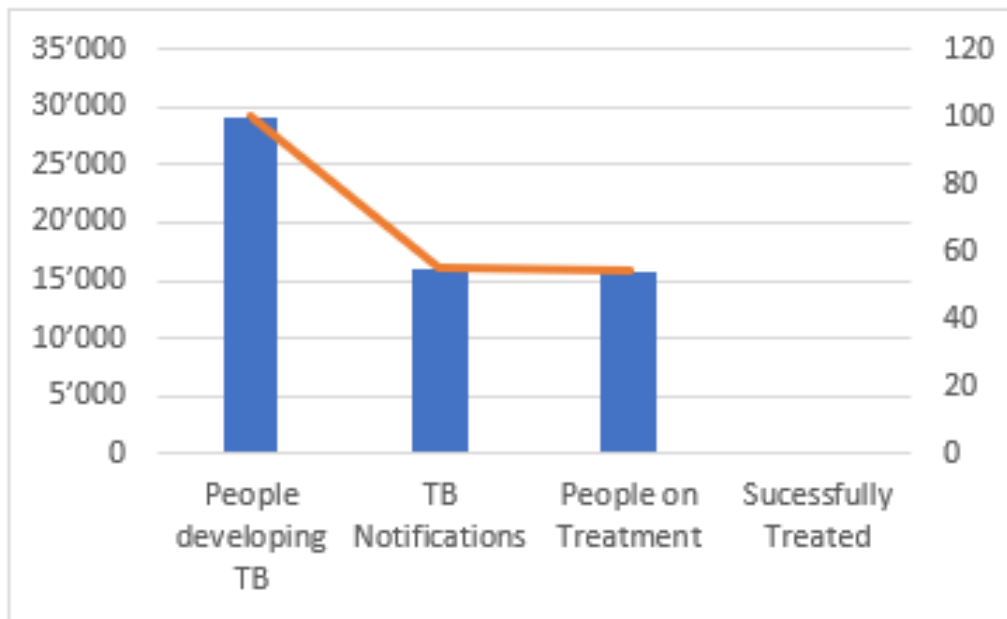

- 2,100 people died because of TB
- 231 Laboratory confirmed people with MDR/RR-TB (WHO data, 2020)

 - To build the capacity of college health workers on youth centered, rights-based integrated TB&HIV care and support in 10 State Universities in each of the 10 provinces of Zimbabwe.
 - To raise awareness about TB, mental health and the rights-based approach in the context of TB&HIV among students living with HIV in Zimbabwe's Higher Education Sector
 - To advocate for TB quality care and support services that are free from stigma and discrimination in college health facilities for students living with HIV.
 - To conduct community-led monitoring of youth centered, rights-based integrated TB and HIV services in 10 universities in each of the 10 provinces of Zimbabwe.
 - To participate and engage in TB advocacy and accountability initiatives at national, regional, and global levels.
