Results of the Global Drug Facility's 2024 Tender for Delamanid Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. What is delamanid and why is it important for treating drug-resistant tuberculosis (DR-TB)?

The World Health Organization (WHO) has recommended delamanid since 2014 for the treatment of multidrug-resistant tuberculosis (MDR-TB). According to WHO's most recent rapid communication from August 23, 2024¹, delamanid is now also recommended as part of two new six-month regimens that combine bedaquiline, delamanid, and linezolid, alongside levofloxacin or clofazimine, as tested in the BEAT-Tuberculosis clinical trial. Delamanid is also included in nine-month regimens for treating MDR/RR-TB without fluoroquinolone resistance, as tested in the endTB clinical trial.

2. How many suppliers were eligible to bid on the recent GDF tender for delamanid?

There were two (2) eligible suppliers of delamanid 50mg—Otsuka being the innovator and Mylan/Viatris operating under a territorially-restricted licensing agreement. Only one supplier—Otsuka—is eligible for delamanid 25mg supply. Additional qualified suppliers are encouraged to participate in future GDF delamanid tenders.

3. What are GDF's quality requirements for medicines?

GDF's quality assurance policy is detailed on the Stop TB Partnership website: https://www.stoptb.org/suppliers/quality-assurance. Medicines eligible for procurement via GDF must be prequalified by WHO's Prequalification of Medicines Programme (PQP), authorized by a Stringent Regulatory Authority (SRA), or recommended by the Global Fund's Expert Review Panel (ERP).

4. What are the results of the GDF tender?

Under ITB-Iplus/GDF-MED/2024/1, the awards for delamanid supplies are as follows:

5. What is the significance of the recent price reduction for delamanid?

Effective September 1, 2024, the price of a Mylan/Viatris delamanid 50mg treatment course (tx) decreased from US\$1,125/tx to US\$800/tx, representing a 29% price reduction. This marks a

significant decrease from the original Otsuka price of US\$1,700/tx in 2016, and a 33% decrease from the recent Otsuka price of US\$1,190/tx in July 2023. This price reduction will enhance the accessibility of delamanid in low- and middle-income countries.

6. How does the current price compare to previous prices?

Below is a breakdown of the changes in delamanid 50mg treatment course pricing over time:

7. Why is this price reduction happening now?

GDF's tender was launched in response to the entry of a new quality-assured supplier of delamanid to the market – Mylan/Viatris received WHO PQP approval to manufacture delamanid with their own active pharmaceutical ingredient. In 2024, the TB Procurement and Market-Shaping Action Team (TPMAT)—a global initiative focused on improving access to TB products and addressing market challenges—set new target prices for key TB medicines, including delamanid 50mg. GDF incorporated this target price in its 2024 tender. This contributed to Mylan/Viatris decreasing their price of delamanid 50mg by 29%, bringing the cost to US\$800 per treatment course.

This approach highlights the importance of partner collaboration and dedicated suppliers in securing affordable TB medicines. With additional supply capacity and new lower prices for delamanid, GDF aims to offer more affordable treatment options and ensure a steady supply of delamanid.

8. How can countries access delamanid 50mg from Viatris at the new reduced price?

Countries that can procure delamanid 50mg supplied by Mylan/Viatris and, thus, access delamanid at the new reduced price are listed in Annex 1, Tables 1 and 3. 9. Which countries are eligible to receive these products and prices through GDF?

GDF will supply delamanid 50mg tablets and 25 mg dispersible tablets in accordance with the territorial restrictions imposed by each supplier, as described in Annexes 1 and 2.

A total of 136 countries or territories are eligible to procure delamanid 50mg via GDF.

The majority of countries (94 out of 136) are eligible to procure delamanid 50mg from both Otsuka or Mylan/Viatris; however, 32 countries may only procure delamanid 50mg produced by Otsuka, and 10 countries may only procure delamanid 50mg produced by Mylan/Viatris.

Delamanid 25mg dispersible tablets are currently only produced by Otsuka, with 126 countries eligible to procure via GDF (Annex 2).

For the countries which wish to procure delamanid via GDF but are not included in these lists, GDF will contact the suppliers on a case-by-case basis; however, supplier approval cannot be guaranteed.

10. Are there any anticipated limitations with the delamanid supply?

No. There are currently no anticipated limitations or supply issues with delamanid, and GDF does not foresee any delays in processing orders.



11. Can we expect additional delamanid suppliers and lower prices in the near future?

Yes. Additional suppliers are developing delamanid. Once their products meet the GDF quality assurance requirements for procurement eligibility, new competitive tenders should lead to lower prices.

12. Is delamanid included in GDF's Strategic Rotating Stockpile?

Yes. Delamanid is included in GDF's strategic Rotating Stockpile (SRS).

GDF has reached an agreement with Otsuka to provide delamanid 50mg and 25mg dispersible tablets to the SRS as consignment stock thereby allowing GDF to pay Otsuka for these formulations only after GDF clients purchase them. This arrangement eliminates the financial risk for GDF in the event that SRS inventories for both products remain unsold. It also improves GDF's cash flow: GDF is able to redirect funds that would otherwise be used to purchase these products for the SRS towards increasing safety stock of other TB medicines as a buffer against unexpected fluctuations in demand.

Otsuka is the second supplier to offer GDF products on consignment for its SRS. Janssen has offered bedaquiline 100mg and 20mg tablets to GDF on consignment since September 2020.

13. What are the estimated prices of delamanid-based regimens?
